1979

1981

Joe and Bill take over American Industrial Maintenance Systems, becoming General Contractors on small healthcare projects, insurance claims repair and industrial machine painting.

1985

AIMS awarded first Higher **Education Project for** Mercy College.

1986

Consumer Maintenance and American Industrial Maintenance become one company – AIMS Systems. Main office was built on 8 Mile Road in Livonia.



1988

Tim Belanger joins AIM Systems as Director of Business Development and adds another company, AIM Construction, to the mix. A third company, AIMS Group Inc., was added to pursue CM and Design Build work. **Consumer Maintenance** folds and we became one company known as AIMS Group with a DBA as AIMS Construction.

1995

2009
